SERMON



Scattered to Gather Brian Clay

Just before Jesus left for Heaven, he gave his Church the commission to *“go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you to obey.”* Once he said this, he takes off, but leaves the Church with the Holy Spirit. It is now a cooperation, a partnership, between the Church and the Holy Spirit to carry out Jesus’ Mission. The book of Acts describes how this happened. It began with tongues of fire resting on each one of them. Once it touched them, they were filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking with an authority they’ve never had before. They began doing things no one other than Jesus had the power to do. In other words, the very Spirit who lived in Jesus now lives in them. But they shouldn’t have been surprised by this because Jesus, in Acts 1: 8 says, *“You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you...”* But that’s not all he said. *“...and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth”.*
